- (8) How the increased intake capacity of College would resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel in the State and improve the availability of such medical manpower in the State: -

This will help the State Government to resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel. Besides, since the majority of the doctors of this faculty are practicing in rural areas, the proposed increase in intake capacity would increase the availability of doctors in these areas.

- The restrictions imposed by the State Government, if any, on students who are not (9) domiciled in the State from obtaining admissions in the State be specified:-As per the rules laid down by the Government of Maharashtra from time to time.
- (10) Full justification for increase in admission capacity: -Increase in admission capacity would create more educational opportunities for aspiring students and will help the State Government to resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel. Besides, since the majority of the doctors of this faculty are practicing in the rural area, the proposed increase in the intake capacity would increase the availability of doctors in these areas.
- (11) Ayurved doctors to population ratio to be achieved 1:1000

The Principal, APES's M.S. Ayurvedic College, Hospital and Research Institute, Kudwa, Gondia, Dist - 441 614 had applied to the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik to increase the admission capacity of B.A.M.S. course and the said University has recommended to this Government to grant approval to the proposal. The Government of Maharashtra, after conducting inspection of college through the Directorate of AYUSH, Mumbai and considering the report thereof, has decided to issue "No Objection Certificate" to the applicant to increase the admission capacity of B.A.M.S. Course from 60 to 100 seats.

It is certified that -

- The applicant owns and manages a 100 bedded Hospital. a)
- It is desirable in the public interest to increase the admission capacity of B.A.M.S. b) Course from 60 to 100 seats.
- Increase in the admission capacity of B.A.M.S. Course from 60 to 100 by the APES's c) M.S. Ayurvedic College, Hospital and Research Institute, Kudwa, Gondia, Dist -**441 614** is feasible.
- It is also certified that adequate clinical material as per the norms of Central Council is d) available with the existing Ayurved College.

It is further certified that in case the Applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Ayurved College as per Central Council norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Council / Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.
